**A B MAIN SERVICE (VEHICLE INTERIOR)**

1.   Check condition and security of seats and seatbelts
2.   Check operation of all lamps, horns and warning indicators
3.   Check operation of front/rear wipers and washers and condition of wiper blades
4.   Check operation of parkbrake
5.   Replace pollen filter

**MAIN SERVICE (VEHICLE EXTERIOR)**

6.   Annual corrosion/cosmetic inspection
7.   Check tyre pressures, condition and tread depth.
8.   Remove road wheels
9.   Inspect brake pads for wear, calipers for leaks and disks for condition
10.   Replace Brake Fluid **(Every 3 years)\***
11.   Drain fuel sedimentor **(Diesel)**
12.   Renew fuel filter element **(Diesel)**
13.   Refit road wheels to opposite sides of the same axle ( Use anti-sieze compound on spigot bore ) - **Not vehicles fitted with uni-directional tyres**
14.   Check operation of door checks, bonnet catch & fuel flap and lubricate door checks
15.   Apply lubricant to door seals - **Russian and Nordic markets only**

**MAIN SERVICE (UNDER BONNET)**

16.   Check anti-freeze specific gravity
17.   Renew coolant **(Every 10 years)**
18.   Renew spark plugs
19.   Renew air cleaner element
20.   Check condition of ancillary driving belt
21.   Renew ancillary driving belt **(Petrol)**
22.   Renew ancillary driving belt **(Diesel)**
23.   Renew camshaft drive belt, tensioner and idler pulley **(Diesel)**
24.   Check/top up brake, PAS, and clutch fluid levels and screen washer reservoirs
25.   Check battery condition
26.   Check/top up battery electrolyte level
27.   Renew engine oil and filter
28.   Apply grease to gearchange cable connectors **(First service only)**

**A B MAIN SERVICE (UNDER VEHICLE)**

29.   Renew manual transmission oil - **(Every 10 years)**
30.   Renew automatic transmission oil - **(Every 10 years)**
31.   Renew power transfer unit oil - **(Every 10 years)**
32.   Renew rear differential oil - **(Every 10 years)**
33.   Check for free play in all suspension mounting rubbers
34.   Check condition of all suspension, driveshafts and steering boots and gaiters
35.   Replace all flexible brake hoses - **(Every 6 years)\***
36.   Check visually brake servo hose, brake, fuel, PAS and clutch pipes, unions, and electrical harnesses for chafing, leaks and corrosion
37.   Check for fluid leaks
38.   Check exhaust system for leaks, security and damage

**A B MAIN SERVICE (UNDER VEHICLE)**

39.   Check steering rod ball joint fixings and condition of ball joints and dust covers  
If fault lamp(s) are illuminated, interrogate that system using IDS and report findings\*
40.   Carry out road test **(see WARNING over page)**
41.   Reset service interval announcement indicator
42.   Endorse service record
43.   Check for any applicable outstanding service actions or recalls
44.   Report any unusual features of vehicle condition and additional work required

The maintenance items listed, are those recommended for vehicles operating under normal driving, road and climatic conditions. More frequent attention may be necessary if the vehicle is subject to stop/start operation, extremes of temperature, dusty conditions, off road driving or frequent towing of trailers.
